To Show Kindness to the Kindred of the Founder of the Faith

*"God hath bidden you to show forth kindliness towards My kindred, but He hath granted them no right to the property of others. He, verily, is self-sufficient, above any need of His creatures."*¹

"He hath granted them no right to the property of others."

The injunction to show kindness to Bahá'u'lláh's kindred does not give them a share in the property of others. This is in contrast to Shí'ih Muslim practice, in which lineal descendants of Muḥammad are entitled to receive a share of a certain tax."²
